





"Angels from God... ...in our lives forever"

Cheryl and Jeff Forstrom's daughter Alyssa was born with spina bifida, a condition in which the bones of the spine do not form properly around the spinal cord, limiting her mobility and causing pain. The couple quickly learned that this would bring a life of hospital visits, surgery and physical therapy for Alyssa and the family would need the expertise, support and care of many individuals.

The Forstroms have been by their 9-year-old daughter's side as she has undergone more than 20 surgeries over the years. They have utilized medical services close to their Upper Peninsula home near Iron Mountain but most recently came to Providence Park Hospital in Novi. Last summer, they drove nine hours so Michael Mendelow, MD, Orthopedic Surgeon, could perform three surgeries to straighten Alyssa's spine, which was bent at a 150-degree angle. Cheryl said it was "scary going that far away from home," especially knowing they would be gone for over a month. It wasn't long, though, before they found a home away from home.

Cheryl fondly speaks about her family's experience at Providence Park, recalling their first visit with Dr. Mendelow. He spoke with them "eye-to-eye and didn't talk down" to them, even when Cheryl took out two pages of questions. Over four hours later, they knew Alyssa was in good hands and never looked back.

Remote technology

brings stroke experts to bedside

New remote robot technology is now being used within St. John Providence Health System to leverage the expertise of stroke experts for real time evaluation and treatment of stroke patients. A remote presence network connects stroke specialists and patients, enabling physicians to evaluate patients without travel time to reach off-site locations.

Art Van Elslander's generous gift to the Providence Neurosciences program funded the purchase of this technology. Robots are currently in place at Providence and Providence Park Hospitals and Genesys, a sister hospital in Grand Blanc. St. John Hospital and Medical Center (SJH&MC) and St. John River District Hospital are next to be added.

Using robots, specialists can be at the patient bedside within minutes, enabling patients to be treated up to one hour faster. With quicker evaluation and treatment, the possibility of injury to the brain decreases.

The sooner a stroke is treated, the better the outcome for the patient.

The robot is a sophisticated, audiovisual, Internet-based system. Using laptop control stations, physicians and hospital staff can activate the robots at the patient's bedside. Patients, physicians and staff can see and hear one another. The specialist has access to labs and patient imaging data such as CT and MRI. Family members can also talk to the remote physician and hospital staff, easing the transition when transfer to another location is necessary for advanced treatment.

Depending on their condition and location, patients may be treated with tPA – intravenous thrombolytic drugs, which must be administered within 3 to 4-1/2 hours of the onset of stroke. If endovascular treatment is required, patients are transferred to one of the Comprehensive Stroke Centers at Providence, Providence Park or SJH&MC. The key is getting expertise to the bedside and making decisions quickly.

The kindness and care of the staff combined with their passion for healing enabled the Forstroms to focus their energy and attention on Alyssa’s healing. They were able to stay at the Staybridge Suites on the hospital campus, courtesy of Providence Park Hospital. The attentiveness and concern of doctors, nurses and physical therapists, along with daily kindnesses, such as invitations to dinner, special visits and get-well cards from staff, friends and family helped ease the stay of Alyssa and her parents during the intense month away from home.

Alyssa remembers one special visitor, Parker, Providence Park Hospital’s Therapy-Facility Dog (see related story). Having left the two family dogs behind to make the trip, Alyssa looked forward to the days when the black Labrador retriever with the soft brown eyes would come to see her. Parker would never replace her dogs Max and Fanci, but Parker brought a smile to Alyssa’s face when he nestled up to her and gently put his paws on her legs.

Cheryl says the family is forever grateful for the “angels from God” who welcomed them during their daughter’s hospital stay and embraced them with caring arms.

Therapy-Facility Dogs bring smiles

Four-legged volunteers now visit and comfort patients, visitors and associates at Providence and Providence Park Hospitals on a regular basis. Wilbur is a golden retriever who spends 40 hours per week at the Southfield hospital as part of the Therapy-Facility Dogs program, while Parker, a black Labrador retriever, spends time at the Novi campus.

The best just got better

Van Elslander gift advances Neurosciences program

St. John Providence Health System’s (SJPHS) internationally recognized Neurosciences Center of Excellence is moving years ahead in expanding technology and enhancing patient care with a substantial gift from Art Van Elslander, a longtime supporter of SJPHS. The lead gift from Mr. Van Elslander names the west region’s Neurosciences Center, which is housed on both the Southfield and Novi campuses of Providence Hospital, with the center’s hub based at Providence Park Hospital.

The Neurosciences Center has already earned a world-renowned reputation with one of the most comprehensive teams of multi-disciplinary specialists and subspecialists. The center was one of the first in the region to earn advanced certification through the Joint Commission as a Primary Stroke Center and was one of the first in America to perform liquid aneurysm treatments. It has become a destination treatment center for craniofacial/reconstructive surgery, endoscopic brain surgery, and minimally invasive and complex spine treatments. Specialists at the center perform some of the most leading-edge and complex skull-based tumor procedures globally.

The Van Elslander gift, the largest received by SJPHS, is already taking the Neurosciences Center to new heights. The center has deployed

the first phase of the Regional Tele-Health Network, which allows physicians to visit a patient’s bedside “virtually” through remote-presence technology. Soon, many partner health care sites throughout Michigan, which may not have neurology specialists on staff or on call, will also be able to utilize the network to remotely tap into the center’s specialists who will provide the specialized care for patients.

The gift has also helped in the development of an Epilepsy Monitoring Unit at Providence Park Hospital. This four-bed unit, to open later this year, will be equipped with advanced epilepsy monitoring devices, including all-digital video-EEG monitoring. With this technology, experts will be able to identify seizures and pinpoint seizure locations. The center will also soon open a new Dizziness, Balance and Falls Clinic through a partnership with the Michigan Ear Institute, enhancing the internationally recognized existing clinic.

“Mr. Van Elslander’s generous donation is allowing us to further realize our dream of creating a hospital of the future by greatly enhancing our Neurosciences program, which is already recognized as a premier center of excellence,” said Dr. Patricia Maryland, President and CEO, SJPHS.

Miracle on Moross and Mack Ave.

"Today's my birthday," announced Carl DeRaedt, a dapper, silver-haired gentleman. "I'm two months old," he said, smiling. "Two months ago today, I got my life back."

Carl's second chance at life came on Dec. 23, 2009, amid final preparations for Christmas. Only a week earlier, the 74-year-old came to St. John Hospital and Medical Center (SJH&MC) to have four stents put into the arteries of his heart because of a minor heart attack. The procedure was successful and Carl went about his daily activities, driving friends to doctor appointments and spending Sunday mornings at St. John Senior Community "chauffeuring" patients from their rooms to attend mass. He was feeling great and life couldn't be better.

Carl is fortunate not only to have a St. John doctor, but one who also happens to be his son-in-law: Gary Bill, MD. The doctor asked his wife Kim to bring her father to the office for an EKG; the appointment was on Dec. 23. When Dr. Bill reviewed the EKG, he heard a murmur that was not evident previously. Almost before Carl knew what was happening, Kim was driving him to SJH&MC's Guild Emergency Center for an echocardiogram, an ultrasound test that picks up sound waves as they bounce off different parts of the heart. Just a precautionary test...but Dr. Bill thought something could be dangerously wrong.

Within minutes of arriving at the Emergency Center and having the test, Carl's condition changed dramatically. The muscles connecting the mitral valve to his heart had ruptured. This meant that the critical opening and closing of the valve that controls the flow of blood into the heart vessel was no longer functioning and blood was flowing

backward. Thomas LaLonde, MD, Chief of Cardiology, and his team sprang into action, putting Carl on a ventilator and rushing him to the heart catheterization lab where a balloon pump was inserted. Sanjay Batra, MD, a Thoracic Surgeon, was available to immediately perform an emergency mitral valve repair.

By everyone's account, Carl should have died that day – but he didn't. Dr. Bill's alert diagnosis of the heart murmur, the quick intervention of Dr. LaLonde's team in the Emergency Center and cath lab, as well as Dr. Batra's skill in the operating room made all the difference in this unusual case. (In his entire career, Dr. LaLonde has seen only one other case like this, a catastrophic event that most patients do not survive.) But that day, everything was right: the right hospital, the right doctors and the right intervention.

Carl woke up in his hospital room three days later unaware of the seriousness of what happened that day before Christmas Eve. Everything came together to give Carl a second chance at life. His daughter calls it a miracle. St. John Providence Health System calls it a passion for healing.

Talking about this experience a few months later, Carl gives the "thumbs up" sign. He jokingly talks about the pig valve used in the repair and laughs when asked if he gave up eating pork in deference to the animal that took part in saving his life. Now that he can drive again, Carl has happily returned to St. John Senior Community to assist his friends. What really puts a sparkle in his eye is being able to join his golfing buddies this season and celebrating many more birthdays on the 23rd of every month.

Donation supports

Cardiovascular Hybrid Surgical Laboratory

Gretchen Valade, a generous philanthropic supporter of St. John Hospital and Medical Center (SJH&MC) for many years, has contributed \$3 million for the creation of a fully equipped Cardiovascular Hybrid Surgical Laboratory.

"We are so thankful to our very generous friend for supporting this innovative program," said Diane Radloff, President, SJH&MC. "This fantastic gift for new technology, along with our superb physicians, will heighten our leading-edge cardiac care services, allowing us to better serve our community."

As the anchor of a new \$5 million Minimally Invasive Structural Heart Program at SJH&MC, the laboratory will be used to perform the most advanced non-surgical and minimally invasive surgical cardiovascular procedures. These procedures include small incision, minimally invasive aortic valve replacement surgery and non-surgical (percutaneous) mitral valve repair and aortic valve replacement. The percutaneous (through the skin) procedures are similar to balloon angioplasty, where a catheter is guided into the area being treated via a small incision in

the groin, eliminating the need for an incision in the chest.

"These types of procedures are the wave of the future for tertiary cardiac care centers," said Thomas LaLonde, MD, Chief of Cardiology, SJH&MC. "It is imperative that we add this Cardiovascular Hybrid Surgical Laboratory to maintain our leadership position in cardiac care and offer the most up-to-date procedures to our patients."

The new Cardiovascular Hybrid Surgical Laboratory will make SJH&MC eligible for important research grants for cardiac care technology that are only awarded to hospitals with existing hybrid labs. SJH&MC was already selected as a semi-finalist among 117 hospitals nationwide for a prestigious grant to begin clinical trials in collaboration with medical product companies to study percutaneous valve repair and replacement.

The new lab will be one of the most versatile treatment centers in the country. In addition to treating valve disease with either non-surgical or minimally invasive surgical procedures, the lab will allow for sophisticated diagnostic tests and a full range of invasive and non-invasive

therapeutic procedures, including angioplasty and the implantation of pacemakers and internal defibrillators. The lab will also be equipped for traditional cardiac surgery.

In previous years, Mrs. Valade, Chairman of Carhartt, Inc. and CEO of Mack Avenue Records, also supported the expansion and renovation at SJH&MC with a \$1 million gift, the Valade Healing Arts Center with a \$1 million donation, and The Suites at SJH&MC with a \$250,000 gift.

Margaret Borden will remember the coming of spring in 2008, not because of the longer days and new growth in her garden, but because she was diagnosed with ovarian cancer. "I'd lived a healthy life, ate well and exercised regularly," she said. "I never smoked, rarely drank and was feeling good. There was nothing I could pinpoint that would make me think I had cancer." It was when her granddaughter commented that Margaret looked as if she was pregnant, that her daughter, Anne Silver, had Margaret see her doctor. Within days, Margaret underwent a series of tests, had more doctor visits and received the dreaded diagnosis.

She was referred to Robert Morris, MD, a specialist in Oncological Gynecology, at St. John Hospital and Medical Center (SJH&MC). He immediately performed surgery but was unable to remove all the cancer. Margaret chose to fight the cancer through an aggressive regimen of chemotherapy throughout the summer and fall. In spring 2009, she underwent another course of chemo rather than waiting until fall. She had things to do.

Margaret speaks fondly of Dr. Morris, "From the moment I met him, I knew he was someone who really cared about his

patients. He told me, 'Don't sit around. I want you to live – go outside, continue gardening and doing the things you love.'" At every appointment, Dr. Morris asked Margaret what she did that day, that week, to make sure she was not letting the cancer take over her life. When she read in "Hour Detroit" magazine that Dr. Morris was recognized as one of metro Detroit's best oncological gynecologists, Margaret was not surprised. Along with her four children and close-knit family, it was Dr. Morris, his staff and their passion for healing that helped her on this journey. She is forever grateful.

Margaret has become an advocate for ovarian cancer education. "I stood up at my Bridge Club and Garden Club and asked, 'Who knows that frequent burping and indigestion are signs of ovarian cancer?'" While breast cancer awareness has become a health care priority, little is done to educate women about ovarian cancer. Margaret's daughter, who has been her patient advocate and support through diagnosis and treatment, echoes her mother's sentiments about the lack of ovarian cancer information available to the general public. They want this to change.

Margaret, Anne and her husband, Cary, have made donations to the Van Elslander Cancer Center at SJH&MC to support the creation of a special Web site for gynecologic cancers. Dr. Morris and his team will lead the development of the site, which will include risk indicators, information on diseases and treatment options, the results of clinical studies and links to support groups. Because of their contributions, other women will have the tools to recognize the early signs of ovarian cancer and be encouraged to see an oncological gynecologist so treatment can be initiated sooner.

As for Margaret, cancer is not slowing her down. The tumor has shrunk to less than half its original size and she continues to follow Dr. Morris' advice not to "sit around." Along with her gardening and club activities, Margaret is looking forward to another journey – this time to southern Europe where she will board a riverboat and travel the Black Sea. The seasons turn and life continues.

Words of a child

spur creation of scholarship fund

The blessing of children – times three. For Cassandra (Cassie) Callaghan, her seven-year-old triplets Alexandra (Alex), Alivia and Jack are her gift. Born prematurely at 32 weeks, Alex was the biggest and strongest of the three but she developed physical disorders that affected her ability to walk. As a toddler, Alex spent several hours a week in physical therapy at Providence Park Hospital, where Cassie and Alex soon came to know many of the other children and their families. Together, they formed a community of care and interest in one another.

Alex was 2-1/2 years old when she heard that one of the children had to leave physical therapy because insurance would not cover any more sessions. To Alex, the solution was simple, “That’s okay. My mom will pay for it.” Less than six weeks later, Cassie gave the hospital an \$8,000 check from her first golf outing. The Pediatric Rehabilitation Scholarship Fund was created.

This year’s annual golf outing builds on the success of previous ones and reunites friends and families to raise funds. Proceeds will pay for equipment for children, extended therapy not covered by insurance and horseback-riding gear, so children with disabilities

Infant Mortality Program

builds hope for healthy babies

Reducing infant mortality has been a longtime struggle in Detroit. The Infant Mortality Program (IMP) sponsored by St. John Providence Community Health has become a beacon of hope for successful childbirth and better parenting skills.

The IMP provides services to at-risk pregnant women, infants and families to reduce the high number of infant deaths in Detroit and Wayne County. The services help to build and sustain families, promote literacy and increase access to health care for those who are underserved and underinsured. In the past year, the IMP helped bring 52 healthy babies into the world (with no infant deaths), assisted 74 mothers with mentoring by partners, and educated 44 parents who graduated from parenting classes.

Because of support from the community, the IMP has assisted young mothers like

Angela, who was introduced to the program during her first pregnancy. She was matched with a mentor who provided her with the information, support and resources she needed to have a healthy baby. When Angela expressed concern about her ability to safely parent her baby because she was unable to read, she was matched with a tutor, who worked one-on-one with her. Angela expressed that for all of her life, she had been dependent on others who often let her down. She wanted to be self-sufficient. With help from the IMP, she was able to find low-income housing, obtain her driver’s license, purchase a car, improve her reading skills and enroll in an adult education program. Today, Angela and her two children are doing well.

can enjoy a day at the farm. Cassie recalls another family being told by their insurance company that their son “could crawl until he was four” because their policy would not cover the cost of a walker for him. She couldn’t believe it. This is why the scholarship fund was created. Now, the hospital provides walkers, helmets and other assistive devices for children who need these to accommodate their disabilities – no questions asked, no strings attached. Parents never see a bill.

Cassie “pays” by organizing the annual golf outing with her friend, Lesley McGovern. She says that she “can’t imagine not doing this. It’s a part of me. It gives me purpose.” In fact, planning the golf outing has become a family affair. All three of her children helped her last year – stuffing, sealing and stamping more than 400 invitations. Through Alex’s experience, Alivia and Jack have learned tolerance of other children with special needs. Cassie knows they will care for Alex and make sure she has whatever she needs; the bonds are strong. “I will never worry about Alex as long as Alivia and Jack are there,” she said.

Cassie brought Alex to Providence Park Hospital, not only because she found an excellent, supportive surgeon, Michael Mendelow, MD, and a caring Physical Therapist, Stephanie Herrle, but also because of the value the staff places on caring for spiritual needs in addition to physical ones. Over the years, the proceeds have supported the hospital’s Christmas Store, Clothes Closet and “Believe in Miracles” program for cancer patients who need financial assistance to continue their treatment. The outing also supported the conversion of an old post office in Detroit’s Brightmoor District into a clinic where low-income residents can receive basic medical tests, dental work, counseling and other health care services.

Dave will continue to be involved with the golf outing as long as he can influence how the proceeds are used. With dedicated volunteers like Dave, St. John Providence Health System’s passion for healing, commitment to serve the community and care for the needs of the poor will live well into the future.

Dedication to program keeps Kids on the Go

Summer is a time of play and fun when children are on the go. But for young kids with special needs, it can be a time when their skills decline because they don't have access to programs they need.

As a Speech-Language Pathologist, Kristy Piana Schena learned early in her career that there was a lack of health care benefits for children age 6 and younger who have a need for therapy when the school year ends. There was especially a lack of programs with an interdisciplinary approach; if they existed, they were limited and costly.

That's why Kids on the Go was created. Founded by Kristy, now Executive Director, the program is celebrating 12 years as a non-profit pediatric program designed to provide special-needs children (ages 3 to 6) with physical, occupational and speech therapy during the summer. Kids on the Go provides two-hour sessions twice a week for six weeks at no cost to the children's families.

Each Kids on the Go classroom is staffed by a certified or licensed speech-language pathologist, physical therapist and occupational therapist with assistance from volunteers. Children are placed in classrooms according to their skill level and Individualized Education Plan (IEP) goals, established at school programs. Weekly themes are addressed through vocabulary

lessons, music, stories, crafts, gross motor activities and hand-writing practice.

Kids on the Go clinics for children ages 3 to 12 focus more on individual needs through enrichment courses that address development disabilities, sensory impairments, speech and language delays, fine motor delays and physical impairments. Clinics include: Better Letters, Once Upon a Story, Little Sluggers Baseball, YogaEd, Music and Art Therapy, and My Chance to Dance.

Affiliated with St. John Providence Community Health and held at Assumption Cultural Center in St. Clair Shores, the program is supported by local businesses, corporations, charitable organizations and private donations. Kristy, now a stay-at-home mom of 5-year-old Anthony and 3-year-old twins Luke and Audrey, spearheads fundraising. In 2009, she helped raise \$62,000 to support Kids on the Go through events and sponsorships.

While Kristy has always advocated for Kids on the Go, she now has a personal stake in the program. Her son Luke was diagnosed with hypotonia, a condition of abnormally low-muscle tone often involving reduced muscle strength. Last summer, Luke attended Kids on the Go for the first time and learned to jump, a great accomplishment and self-esteem booster for the little boy who didn't walk until he was 23 months old.

grateful patients. When Mickey needed surgery for a badly injured ankle, he went to Dr. Salama, since he had performed successful surgery on Debbie's ankle. Their positive experience with Dr. Salama and his team at Providence Hospital inspired them to make a generous contribution in Dr. Salama's honor to support the Department of Orthopedics. The Sterns created a planned gift to recognize the good work of their friend and doctor and to enhance his program. Both procedures were successful, allowing her to walk pain-free and continue her outings to local casinos. Now 98, she told the doctor that she was grateful to have an exceptional quality of life, living years beyond many of her friends.

Dr. Salama knows the importance of giving back and is a member of St. John Providence Health System's "Physicians Who Care," a network of specialty doctors who volunteer their services to ensure that a continuum of care is available for the working poor and uninsured. Because of the physicians' generous gifts of time and talent, and their passion for healing, these patients are assured of receiving diagnostics, treatment and procedures at no cost. Dr. Salama also volunteers his services through Chesed, a physicians' group that offers services to the Jewish community.

Gifts make a difference for youngest patients

Every year, St. John Hospital and Medical Center's Department of Pediatrics and Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) care for approximately 500 children and young adults, up to age 25. Parents of sick children want to ease their child's fears, make them comfortable and be with them during the treatment and recovery process. This can mean spending long hours at their child's bedside – day and night.

The days can range from intense to tedious, with down time between diagnostic tests, therapy sessions and visits from other family members. Children and their family members readily welcome the calming diversion of books, games, DVDs and television to help pass the time.

Because of two generous contributions, the Pediatric Department/PICU is becoming more accommodating and pleasant for children and their families. Roland and Janice Rinke helped the hospital purchase 10 new chairs that fold

out to become beds so a family member can spend the night with a sick child. Added to the ones already in the unit, there is now a chair available for each patient area. No longer will staff have to tell a parent, "I'm sorry, all our bedside chairs have been taken." Roland and Janice have ensured that no child will have to spend the night alone.

Rick and Cat Ruffner answered another need. When Cat toured the unit and saw that there were only six televisions on carts circulated among patients and that DVDs were hard to get, she and her husband chose a gift that would make each child's stay more comfortable. Their gift has allowed the unit to purchase 26-inch flat screen televisions with internal DVD players for patient rooms.

The sound of laughter in the unit has multiplied because of the Ruffners' gift, which has made a big difference to patients and their families.

The multiplier effect: Many gifts make new technology possible

The recent influx of movies filmed in 3-D provides audiences with a dazzling visual experience – images appear to pop off the screen and bring viewers into the action. This enhanced technology has taken adventure films and special effects to a higher level of entertainment.

If one additional dimension can make such a dramatic difference in film viewing, imagine the multiplier effect of a 64-slice CT scan compared to the standard computed tomography (CT) image, which is a two-slice scan. Physicians and CT technologists can manipulate various “cuts” of a 64-slice CT scan to produce precise 3-D images of the human body. This detailed information results in better diagnoses.

St. John River District Hospital recently acquired the equipment to provide patients in the St. Clair County area with access to better imaging capabilities. Orthopedic and vascular surgeons, pulmonologists and urologists were among the first to use post-processing 3-D images obtained from the 64-slice CT scanner. The advanced CT scanner also provides a unique means of studying the beating heart.

Donna Pickett, Registered CT Technologist, describes the images of the heart vessels as “amazing.” Cardiologists can use the 3-D images “to see inside the vessels and actually measure

the obstructions.” With a 64-slice CT scan, doctors can determine if a heart catheterization is the best option for a patient complaining of chest pain and shortness of breath – without subjecting the patient to a risky, invasive procedure. The new tool is making a real difference in the lives of St. John River District’s cardiac patients.

Frank Poma, President of St. John River District Hospital, is proud to say, “We have been blessed with tremendous community support that has allowed us to bring this advanced technology to our hospital.” The hospital received a lead gift of \$750,000 from the estate of Vera Fuller Hanson, an area resident. This gift became the seed money toward a \$1.45 million campaign for purchasing the new scanner and renovating space in the hospital. Hospital Board Member Ken Schultz, Ed.D., chaired the campaign to raise the additional funds and recruited the CT scanner campaign advisory committee comprised of Lee Bacheldor, DO; William Haener; Gilda Hayes-Moskal; Bernard Kuhn; Patricia Manley; Bassam Nasr, MD; Bill Schwarz; and Bill Zweng.

Ken’s wife Caroline and neighbor, Virginia Rivard, formed a committee to host the hospital’s first pig roast last August to help offset the expense of the CT scanner. More than 140 friends of the hospital attended the event, which raised over \$12,800. In addition, the hospital’s annual dinner dance and golf outing have supported the purchase of the scanner; together, these events have raised \$111,000 over the past few years.

“Let go of the need for certainty and leave some room for good.” This was just one of the inspirational notes Danielle Lafata hung throughout her house. And that is how she lived her life. Even after losing her 40-year-old husband Joe suddenly from an aneurysm, followed shortly by the death of the beloved family dog, Danielle kept a smile on her face and stayed strong for her three children: Antonio, Alex and Ella.

When she was diagnosed with cervical cancer just four months after her husband died, Danielle still didn’t waver. Although Danielle drifted in and out of consciousness, everyone let her know when Antonio was on TV and she was aware. With the help, dedication and love of her kids, in-laws, family, friends and the hospice staff, Danielle was able to spend her last weeks at home with those she loved. Surrounded by her family, she passed away peacefully with her son playing her favorite songs on the piano.

St. John Providence Hospice does more than provide physical care for terminally ill patients – the staff and volunteers recognize the uniqueness of each individual and tend to patients’ comfort and needs. For seven years, an annual Hospice Oktoberfest event featuring a silent auction and dinner has been held to support St. John Providence Hospice services.
